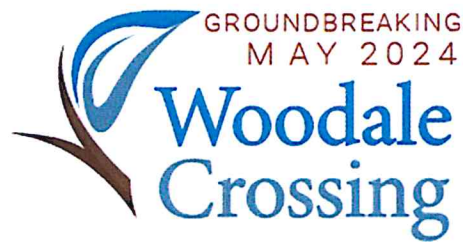

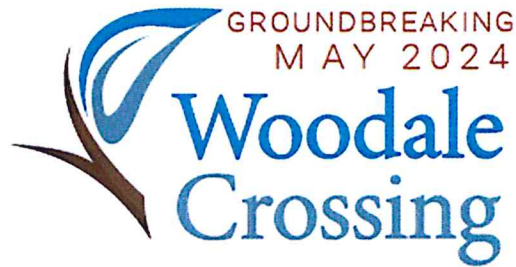

Available on-site services will include socialization and skill-based programming, social services, and supportive home care services.

In a recent survey, 77% of respondents reported that they felt that they were better able to manage stress since moving to Bradley Crossing.
